Personnel planning with Adicom® Graphical Pegboard – easy and fast!

With Adicom Graphical Pegboard, your supervisor and production employees have a tool for scheduling personnel in various production lines more precisely, reliably, and with greater transparency.

Adicom Graphical Pegboard serves both as a planning instrument for the production supervisor and as an information instrument for your employees.

Precise scheduling

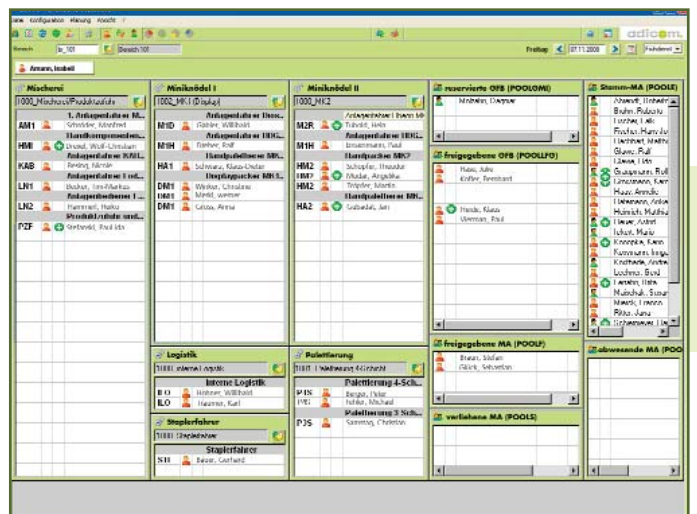
The scheduling of orders, products, and employees on production lines takes place in the supervisor's office. Scheduling activities include the complete mapping of the production unit with areas, production lines, workstations, production order selection, employee assignment to individual workstations, and personnel transfer to other areas.

The scheduling data is incorporated into the actual data. In this way, working hours can be automatically assigned to cost centers, transmitted to cost accounting, or add-ons can be generated for higher-value workstations.

Scheduling can be performed either automatically or manually. With automatic scheduling, orders and job positions are filled from past records, or personnel is scheduled based on a master assignment to a line/workstation, or based on a master skills matrix. With manual scheduling, the supervisor selects the orders and schedules personnel for the entire area.

Rapid information

The supervisor checks the order queue, identifies required qualifications for a workstation, and then receives a color display indicating whether an employee is present or absent. The stamp times on the time clocks, or the access postings at the gates, and the absent times entered in the system, such as vacation or illness, are all incorporated in this graphic display. In this way, if personnel are absent at the start of a shift, the response can be immediate.





Employees can see the workstations to which they are assigned in the current shift on screens located in the production area. The screen display is updated at customizable intervals so that employees can be informed of urgent rescheduling. The display switches to the next day before the shift ends.

This lets employees know where they are scheduled for the next day. If they are in a pool, they have to report to another production area at the start of the next shift. The employees would then be released for other areas, or kept in reserve if there are capacity bottlenecks.

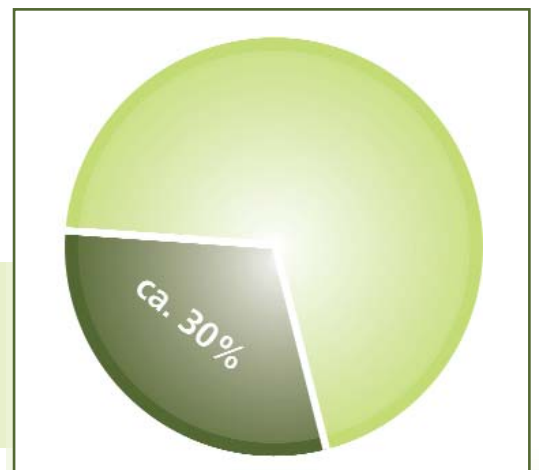
Integration possibilities

As a scheduling and information instrument, Adicom Graphical Pegboard is a module within the Adicom Software Suite. Scheduling personnel is one of the primary objectives of this software. Master data is copied from the modules Adicom Personnel Time & Attendance, Adicom Shop Floor Data Collection, and Adicom Advanced Planning & Scheduling, or from external systems (such as SAP). The actual stamps, and the approved working hours supply the work schedule which can be account-assigned to cost centers.

This data is directly available in Adicom Personnel Time & Attendance or further processing.

Time and cost savings

With Adicom Graphical Pegboard, you get a tailored solution that replaces your manual pegboard. The information and scheduling possibilities of the manual pegboard are retained in the system and supplemented, while the data gathered is automatically forwarded to connected systems. This saves time, and reduces sources of error to a minimum. Your employees no longer have to concern themselves with scheduling tasks as part of their daily work and can concentrate on their core business.
